HE'S GOT THE GRIPS AS PROOF - NOT ME!

MAPS OF GREAT BRITAIN CONTAIN A PROFUSION OF NAMES IDENTIFYING HAMLETS, CITIES, HILLS AND WATERWAYS. THE SAME NAMES USUALLY APPEAR ON MEDIAEVAL MAPS, AND THOUGH IT MAY BE DESCRIPTIVE, COMMENDRATIVE OR AN EPONYM, IT IS HARD TO FIND HOW THEY ORIGINATED. NAMES ARE RARELY CHANGED - INDEED IN THE LAKE DISTRICT ONLY ONE OF THE HILLS HAS BEEN RENAMED THIS CENTURY - BIRKETT FELL ABOVE ULLSWATER.


IN CONTRAST, MOST OF THE ANTARCTIC WAS UNEXPLORED BEFORE THE AMERICAN AERIAL SURVEYS IN THE LATE 1940'S AND PLACE NAMES THUS HAVE ORIGINS IN THE RECENT PAST. THOSE AROUND HALLEY ARE SOME OF THE OLDEST.

THE PIONEER IN THIS AREA OF ANTARCTICA WAS THE SEALER-EXPLORER JAMES WEDDELL, WHO IN 1820 TOOK HIS 150 TON SLOOP'JAME'THROUGH THE PACK AND REACHED 74.15S.ON HIS RETURN, HE NAMED THE NEW FOUND SEA 'KING GEORGE IV' SEA.3 YEARS LATER, AN AMERICAN NAMED MORRELL REACHED 70.0S AND WAS POSSIBLY THE FIRST PERSON TO SEE THE EAST COAST OF GRAHAMLAND.NO FURTHER EXPLORATION TOOK PLACE IN THE 19TH CENTURY, THOUGH IN 1900 KING GEORGE IV SEA WAS RENAMED AFTER ITS DISCOVERER.

THE EARLY 1900'S SAW THE FIRST SCIENTIFIC EXPEDITIONS TO ANTAR-CTICA.IN 1903, A SCOTTISH EXPEDITION UNDER BRUCE SAILED THE SCOTIA' FROM THE SOUTH SANDWICH ISLES AND IN 1904 THE SHIP SIGHTED LAND TO THE EAST OF THE WEDDELL SEA AT 72.14S.THEY FOLLOWED THIS LAND SOUTH TO 74.10S AND NAMED IT AFTER MR.JAMES COATS AND MAJOR ANDREW COATS WHO WERE ARCTIC EXPLORERS WHO HAD SPONSORED THE EXPEDITION.

1909 SAW THE SECOND GERMAN EXPEDITION TO THE ANTARCTIC, AND ITS LEADER FILCHNER TOOK HIS SHIP TO THE HEAD OF THE WEDDELL SEA. A LANDING WAS MADE AT A BAY WHICH WAS NAMED AFTER THE SHIP'S CAPTAIN VAHSEL. A HUT WAS BUILT ON THE ICE, BUT THE SHELF BROKE OFF AND DRIFTED OUT TO SEA JUST AS THE BUILDING WAS COMPLETED. AFTER A HURRIED RETURN TO THE SHIP, THE EXPEDITION SURVIVED THE WINTER BESET IN THE ICE WITHOUT BEING CRUSHED AND REACHED HOME THE FOLLOWING YEAR.

FOLLOWING THIS ROUTE, SHACKLETON SAILED SOUTH IN 1914 IN AN ATTEMPT TO CROSS ANTARCTICA. THE ENDURANCE REACHED COATS LAND AND FOLLOWED THE COASTLINE SOUTH. HE FOUND THREE MAJOR GLACIERS IN THE AREA. THE NORTHERNMOST OF THESE, THE STANCOMBE-VILLS' IS CLEARLY THE GLACIER OF THAT NAME TODAY - BOTH THEN AND NOW, IT HAD A LONG TONGUE OF ICE PROJECTING OFF THE LAND. TO THE SOUTH, SHACKLETON FOUND A LARGE PROTECTED BAY - GLACIER BAY., AND THEN TWO FURTHER GLACIERS: THE ALLAN MACDONALD AND THE DAWSON-LAMBTON. THE WHOLE AREA WAS CALLED THE CAIRD COAST - ALL FOUR NAMES BEING CALLED AFTER SPONSORS OF THE EXPEDITION. IN THE 1930'S THE AREA WAS CLAIMED AS PART OF THE BRITISH ANTARCTIC TERRITORIES, AND THE NAME COATS LAND WAS ALTERED SO THAT IT COVERED ALL THE AREA FROM VAHSEL BAY TO THE NORWEGIAN SECTOR.



BETWEEN THE TWO WARS, LITTLE INTEREST WAS SHOWN IN THIS SECTOR OF THE CONTINENT EXCEPT BY THE NORMEGIANS. IN 1926, A FACTORY WHALING SHIP COMMANDED BY KRISTENSEN DID A SERIES OF SURVEYS 14 QUEEN MAUD LAND.A LIGHT AIRCRAFT WAS FLOWN BY RIISER-LARSEN AND IT IS LIKELY THAT HE GOT AS FAR SOUTH AS THE STANCOMBE-WILLS GLACIER, BECAUSE A REPORT OF THIS TIME SUGGESTS THAT THE GLACIER TONGUE HAD BROKEN OFF.

IGY IN 1957 LEAD TO THE SETTING UP OF FOUR BASES AROUND THE WEDDELL SEA COASTS. THE ROYAL SOCIETY EXPEDITION TRAVELLED SOUTH ON THE 'TOTTAN', CROSSING THE ANTARCTIC CIRCLE ON NEW YEARS DAY 1956 - ONLY THE SECOND SHIP TO REACH SOUTH OF 70.0S SINCE 1914: THE ARGENTINE ICEBREAKER'SAN MARTINE' HAVING PRECEDED HER BY A FEW WEEKS. THE EXPEDITION HAD ORIGINALLY HOPED TO WINTER AT VAHSEL BAY. BUT HEAVY PACK AT 76S PREVENTED THIS. TURNING BACK NORTH, A SCUTH-WEST FACING BAY WITH A GOOD SNOW RAMP PROVIDED A LANDING AREA, AND IT WAS NAMED HALLEY BAY AFTER THE ASTRONOMER ROYAL AND SECRETARY OF THE ROYAL SOCIETY, WHO IN 1699 SAILED SOUTH TO THE EDGE OF THE PACK. IT WAS CLEAR THAT TIME HAD MADE SHACKLETON'S GEOGRAPHY HARD TO INTERPRET. THE STANCOMBE-WILLS ICE TONGUE HAD GONE - THOUGH IT IS NOW REFORMING AGAIN. FURTHER SOUTH, IT SEEMS PROBABLE THAT THE STRANDED ICE AROUND GIN BOTTLE WAS THE ALLAN MACDONALD GLACIER AND THE 1950'S MAP OF THE AREA CALLS THIS ZONE THE MACDONALD ICE RUMPLES. INITIALLY IT WAS THOUGHT THAT HALLEY BAY AND GLACIER BAY MIGHT HAVE BEEN THE SAME, BUT IT IS NOW MORE LIKELY THAT GLACIER BAY IS TO THE SOUTH OF THE STANCOMBE-WILLS IN THE AREA THAT WE NOW KNOW AS THE BAY OF WHALES.

THE ICE SHELF WAS NAMED AFTER JAMES BRUNT - THE SECRETARY OF THE ROYAL SOCIETY IN 1956. IN THE EARLY YEARS, LITTLE TRAVELLING WAS DONE FROM BASE AND IT WAS NOT UNTIL 1960 THAT ROUTES WERE ATTEMPTED INLAND. IN 1961, THE FIRST ROUTE WAS PIONEERED BY ARDUS AND JOHNSON; AND LATER IN THE SAME YEAR THE ARGENTINIANS PLACED A REFUGIO ON THE POINT OF THE ICE SHELF WHICH THEY CALLED CABO ROL. IN 1962, THE FIRST TRACTOR ROUTE WAS PIONEERED BY JARMAN AND LEE KNOWN BY THEIR NICKNAME OF BOB AND PI.THE BOB-PI ROUTE IS THAT USED TODAY, ALTHOUGH MOST OF THE ORIGINAL FEATURES HAVE GONE AND THE BREAKAGE OF A HUGE WINDTAIL IN THE LATE SIXTIES MADE THE ROUTE IMPASSIBLE FOR HEAVY VEHICLES. IN THESE EARLY TRIPS, IT WAS THOUGHT THAT THE CHAOS OF THE HINGE ZONE WAS THE DAWSON-LAMBTON GLACIER., BUT THE NAME WAS LATER REASIGNED MORE CORRECTLY TO A GLACIER TO THE SOUTH OF THE HINGE ZONE ALONG PRECIOUS BAY.

OVER THE YEARS, LOCAL NAMES HAVE PROLIFERATED AT THE WHIM OF FIDS. THE EVER-CHANGING COASTLINE PROVIDES AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE FID TO PUT A NAME ON THE MAP. HALLEY BAY IS NO MORE AND THE CHIPPENTODD CREEKS HAVE DISAPPEARED., WHILE 2ND AND 3RD CHIPS ARE A FRACTION OF THEIR ORIGINAL SIZE. MOBSTER CREEK (NAMED AFTER A DOGTE' OF THAT NAME HAS BEEN JOINED BY CLOCKWORK CREEK. THE IGY BASE HAS GONE AND THE CURRENT BASES ARE LIKELY TO FOLLOW IN THE NEXT DECADE. THE COASTS OF ANTARCTICA HAVE A UNIQUE ABILITY TO AVOID BEING CATA-LOGUED BY MAN.

A SPECK APPEARS ON THE DISTANT HORIZON. IS IT A BIRD? IS IT A MAN? NO IT'S A RUSSIAN HELICOPTER FLYING IN UNEXPECTEDLY TO MAKE THE FIRST FOREIGN VISIT OF 1979. THEY COULDN'T HAVE TIMED IT BETTER AS THE BASE COMMANDER HAD JUST LEFT FOR N9. SOME OF THE MORE UNKIND MEMBERS OF BASE GOT A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF PLEASURE FROM THE THOUGHT OF PETE W., PETE J., AND MARTIN MISSING OUT. HOWEVER THEY WERE WITHIN RADIO DISTANCE - IN FACT ONLY AT THE END OF THE MOBSTER DRUMLINE AND WITHIN SECONDS, THEY WERE FLYING BACK ALONG THE DRUMLINE CNEVER GOING ABOVE 3000 REVS MIND YOUD.

THEY SAY THE UNEXPECTED PLEASURES ARE THE BEST AND THIS WAS CERTAINLY TRUE IN THIS CASE. THE RUSSIAN IT TURNED OUT HAD ARRIVED TO BE PICKED UP BY THE KAPITAN MARKOV LATER IN THE DAY. DAVE AT ONCE DISAPPEARED INTO THE KITCHEN MUTTERING ABOUT TWELVE COURSE MEALS.LITTLE DID THE RUSSIANS REALISE WHAT THEY WERE IN FOR. IN THE MEANTIME, THE REST OF THE BASE DID THEIR BEST TO GET RID OF THE BASE SURPLUS OF BEER ON THE RUSSIANS. IN RETURN, THEY AGREED TO TAKE A SMALL PARTY TO LOOK FOR SEALS AT N9.KODAK SHARES PROBABLY ROSE 2% DURING THE FLIGHT THE DAY WAS CLEAR AND BRIGHT - JUST RIGHT FOR AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY.

DAVE'S MEAL WAS OF COURSE SUPERB: ALL THE MORE REMARKABLE FOR HAVING BEEN PRODUCED AT SUCH SHORT NOTICE.

AFTER THE MEAL, EVERYONE WENT UP TOP FOR AN ANGLO-RUSSIAN BASE PHOT.
THEN IT WAS THE TURN OF THE PEOPLE WHO HAD MISSED THE FLIGHT TO M9
TO GO UP IN THE HELICOPTER - THIS TIME TO LOOK FOR THE KAPITAN
MARKOV' WHICH HAD NOT YET TURNED UP. IN FACT, THE RUSSIAN SHIP DID NOT
TURN UP AT ALL THAT DAY AND SO OUR RUSSIAN GUESTS HAD TO SPEND THE
NIGHT IN A CABOOSE AT THE TOP OF THE RAMP. THE SHIP EVENTUALLY ARRIVED THE NEXT MORNING AND THE RUSSIANS FINALLY FLEW OFF AT ABOUT

THE NEXT VISIT WAS THAT OF THE NORWEGIAN SHIP 'POLARSIRKEL'. SHE HAD VISITED HALLEY TWO YEARS BEFORE, BUT THIS TIME HAD HELICOPTERS ON BOARD. THEIR VISIT WAS EXPECTED AND SO THE WHOLE BASE WAS OUTSIDE TO SEE THEM LAND ON THE HASTILY PREPARED LANDING PADS MARKED OUT WITH THE BASE SUPPLY OF COCOA.

GRAHAM WAS TAKEN UP FIRST IN THE HELICOPTER TO HAVE A LOOK AT THE CRACK AT HALLEY BAY WITH THE AID OF THE ICE RADAR THAT ONE OF THE HELICOPTERS WAS FITTED WITH. HE CAME BACK WITH THE NEWS THAT THE CLOCKWORK ORANGE LOOKED LIKE IT WAS ABOUT TO LOB OFF. NEXT, MOST OF THE BASE WAS TAKEN BY THE HELICOPTER TO THE SHIP IN MOBSTER WHERE WE WERE FIRST SHOWN ROUND AND THEN FED. MOST OF US WERE TRYING TO EAT AS LITTLE AS POSSIBLE KNOWING WHAT DAVE HAD LINED UP FOR LATER. MOST PEOPLE WERE VERY IMPRESSED BY THE AMOUNT THAT WAS GOT INTO THE POLARSIRKEL - A SHIP WHICH IS SMALLER THAN THE "JOHN BISCOE" MOST OF THE SCIENTIFIC PROJECTS WERE HOUSED IN PORTABLE HUTS FIXED IN THE HOD

WE THEN MOVED BACK TO BASE WITH MOST OF THE NORWEGIANS - DRINKING LARGE QUANTITIES OF CHERRY BRANDY ON THE WAY.AT FIRST NO TRANSPORT APPEARED SO WE ALL STARTED WALKING, BUT JOHN AND WURZE SOON APPEARED WITH THE SNOCATS. WOULD YOU BELIEVE THAT IT'S POSSIBLE TO GET 20 PEOPLE IN THE BACK OF A SNOCAT?! CAN TELL YOU IT IS!

WE ARRIVED BACK ON BASE TO PLAY AN INTERNATIONAL GAME OF FOOTBALL.
WELL FOOTBALL WAS WHAT IT WAS MEANT TO BE. THE NORWEGIAMS WON...BUT
I THINK THAT THERE WERE MORE OF THEM.

THEN TO THE BAR WHERE WE TRIED TO TALK THEM INTO DOING SOMETHING ABOUT HALLEY BAY'S QUINESS PROBLEM. THEY RETURNED TO THE SHIP IN THE EARLY HOURS OF THE MORNING YERY MUCH THE WORSE FOR WEAR LEAVING US TO RECOVER AT OUR LEISURE.

SINCE THEN THERE HAVE BEEN NO MORE VISITS. HOWEVER, WE ARE HOPING THAT WE MAY GET VISITS EARLY IN THE SEASON FROM THE WEST GERMANS (IN THE POLARSIRKEL AGAIN) THE ARGIES AND OF COURSE THE RUSSIANS.

THE INFLUENCE OF DEXION AND AVTUR ON ENGLISH LITERATURE FROM CHAUCER TO COLERIDGE.

TODAY. THE WORDS 'AVTUR' AND 'DEXION' HAVE VERY LITTLE MEANING TO THE AVERAGE HOUSEHOLDER, AND THIS, THROUGHOUT HISTORY HAS, BY AND LARGE, ALWAYS BEEN THE CASE, MANY PEOPLE CANNOT ASSOCIATE ANY MEANING WITH THE WORDS, AND THEIR OCCURENCE IN THE MEDIA IS SOMETHING LESS THAN SCARCE. SHOULD YOU GLANCE THROUGH ANY NOTED VOLUME OF POETRY OR PROSE, YOU ARE EXTREMELY UNLIKELY TO FIND ANY MENTION OF EITHER, BE THE WORK ANCIENT OR MODERN, AND YET THE INFLUENCE OF THESE PRODUCTS ON ENGLISH LITERATURE HAS BEEN, TO SAY THE LEAST, PROFOUND, AND THE SEEMING NEGLECT THEREOF IN PUBLISHED BOOKS CAN BE ATTRIBUTED ENTIRELY TO COMMERCIAL REASONS.ART MAY BE PRODUCED FOR ITS OWN SAKE, BUT LITERATURE HAS ALWAYS BEEN, AND IN ALL PROBABILITY WILL CONTINUE TO BE, PRODUCED FOR MONEY, AND MONEY ALONE, TO ACHIEVE THIS, AUTHORS MUST PROMOTE THEIR WORKS TO THE LARGEST POSSIBLE MARKET. WHICH INEVITABLY MEANS THE GENERAL PUBLIC, TO WHOM, FROM TIMES PAST TO TIMES PRESENT, AYTUR AND DEXION HAVE ALWAYS REMAINED OBSCURE, EVEN ESOTERIC, BUT ALWAYS IRRELEVANT: WORDS AND NO MORE. ONLY BY DILIGENTLY READING THROUGH EARLY DRAFTS, ODD NOTES SCRIBBLED IN HASTE, MANUSCRIPTS WHICH WERE TO BE COUNTLESSLY REVISED BEFORE PUBLICATION, ONLY THEN CAN WE UNCOVER, AND APPRECIATE, THE IMPORTANCE OF THESE TWO PRODUCTS OF WESTERN CIVILISATION.

OUR FIRST EXAMPLE COMES FROM CHAUCER'S GREAT WORK, THE CANTERBURY TALES EXCEPT EOR THE KNIGHT'S TALE DEXION AND AYTUR ARE NOT MENT-

AS THESE WERE RELATIVELY SIMPLE PEOPLE, AND EXCEPT FOR PUTTING IT INTO VERSE, CHAUGER HAS SET DOWN THE TALES EXACTLY AS THEY WERE TOLD TO HIM. THE EXAMPLE CHOSEN IS ITSELF FROM THE PROLOGUE. FORMING THE OPENING FOR THE WHOLE WORK, AND READS:

WHEN THAT AVTYRE WITH HIS SHOWRES SOOTE, THE DAEXYONNE HATHE PERCED TO THE ROOTE, AND BATHED ALL THE ERTHE IN SUCHE LIQUORE,



THIRDLY, LET US LOOK AT THE GREAT SOLILOQUY FROM HAMLET ACT III:
TO BE, OR NOT TO BE: THAT IS THE QUESTION:
WHETHER 'TIS NOBLER IN THE WORLD TO SUFFER
THE BOLTS AND SPANNERS OF OUTRAGEOUS DEXION,
OR TO TAKE DRUMS AGAINST A SEA OF AVTUR,
AND BY DISPOSING, WIN IT?

THE 'OUTRAGEOUS DEXION' HAMLET SPEAKS OF IS THE ROYAL DEXION OF DENMARK, PROFANED BY THE MURDER OF THE RIGHTFUL KING BY HIS BROTHER. OF THE ORIGINAL NOTES FOR MILTON'S 'DEXION LOST', NOTHING REMAINS BUT THE TITLE, WHICH IS RECORDED IN AN ENTRY IN ONE OF MILTON'S DIARIES: 'I PLAN TO WRITE ME A POEME, THE WHICH SHALL BE OF GREAT LENGTHE AND WHICH SHALL BE CALL'D 'DEXION LOST'.

MILTON HIMSELF DESTROYRD ALL ORIGINAL SKETCHES AFTER THE SUCCESSFUL PUBLICATION OF 'PARADISE LOST'.

OF THE MANY WRITINGS OF WILLIAM BLAKE, THE BEST EXAMPLE OF THE INFLUENCE OF DEXION AND AVTUR ON HIS WORK, MUST BE THE ORIGINAL DRAFT OF 'THE NEW JERUSALEM', WHOSE IMMORTAL LINES WE NOW PRODUCE:

AND DID THOSE FEET IN ANCIENT TIME
WALK UPON ENGLAND'S MOUNTAINS GREEN?
AND WAS THE HOLY AVTUR DRUM
ON ENGLAND'S PLEASANT PASTURE SEEN?
AND DID THE DEXION DIVINE
SHINE FORTH UPON OUR CLOUDED HILLS?
AND WAS JERUSALEM BUILDED HERE
AMONGST THOSE DARK SATANIC MILLS?

BRING ME MY DRUMS OF BURNING GOLD BRING ME MY SPANNERS OF DESIRE BRING ME MY BOLTS, O CLOUDS UNFOLD BRING ME MY DEXION OF FIRE I WILL NOT CEASE FROM MENTAL FIGHT NOR SHALL THE BOLTS SLEEP IN MY HAND TILL WE HAVE BUILT JERUSALEM IN ENGLAND'S GREEN AND PLEASANT LAND.

THIS WAS IN THE EARLY DAYS OF THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION, OF INCREASES IN THE NUMBER OF SCHOOLS, AND CONSEQUENTLY IN THE NUMBERS OF LITERATE PEOPLE. CLEARLY A CHANGE OF WORDS WOULD BE PROFITABLE IF PUBLICATION WAS CONTEMPLATED. SO IT WAS, AND ONLY THE ONE COPY OF THIS EARLIER VERSION SURVIVES. THE INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION INDEED WAS TO BE THE CAUSE OF THE DECLINE OF DEXION AND AVTUR AS SOURCES OF POETIC AND LITERARY INSPIRATION. THE RISE OF THE INDUSTRIAL MIDDLE CLASS, AND THE RAPID SPREAD OF LITERACY IN THE WORKING CLASSES SERVED TO BRING ABOUT A SITUATION WHERE IT BECAME INCREASINGLY PROFITABLE TO PRODUCE LITERATURE TAILORED SPECIFICALLY FOR THESE SECTIONS OF THE POPULACE, AND AS ALSO THE PRODUCTION OF LITERATURE WAS GRADUALLY INFILTRATED BY THE LOWER SOCIAL ORDERS, SO THE PRODUCTION OF WORKS WHICH OWED NO INSPIRATION TO AVTUR OR DEXION ALSO INCREASED, EVENTUALLY REPLACING THE OLDER STYLE OF WRITING COMPLETELY BY THE EARLY 19TH CENTURY. THE MOST RECENT AUTHOR TO WHOM ANY MANUSCRIPT REFERENCES TO DEXION AND AVTUR MAY BE ATTRIBUTED IS

THAT CHAUCER SHOULD HAVE CHOSEN TO CHANGE THIS TO ITS BETTER KNOWN FORM, SUBSTITUTING 'APRILE'FOR'AVTYRE' AND 'DROGHTE OF MARCHE' FOR DAEXYONNE MAY AT FIRST SEEM TO BE A POINTLESS EXERCISE, AS THE POP-ULACE OF THE TIME WERE LARGELY ILLITERATE, BUT BEARING IN MIND THAT IT ALWAYS PAYS TO ADVERTISE, AND THAT PROTOTYPE PRINTING PRESSES WERE ALREADY IN EXISTANCE, CHAUCER WAS QUITE CORRECT TO MAKE THE CHANGES WHICHWOULD OPTIMISE THE MARKET POTENTIAL OF THE BOOK.

OF LANGLAND'S 'VISION OF PIERS PLOUGHMAN', NO EARLY DRAFTS HAVE EVER COME TO LIGHT. LANGLAND HIMSELF IS AN OBSCURE CHARACTER, BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN A CLERIC, HE PRODUCED NO OTHER WRITTEN WORKS WHICH HAVE SURVIVED, AND OF THE END OF HIS LIFE, NOTHING IS KNOWN, BUT THROUGH-OUT HIS BOOK, WORDS AND SHORT PHRASES OF TWO AND THREE SYLLABLES EXIST WHICH, WHEN SUBSTITUTED BY "AVTUR AND DEXION", MAKE SUFFICIENT GRAMMATICAL SENSE FOR IT TO BE REASONABLE TO SUPPOSE THAT LANGLAND

USED THEM IN HIS ORIGINAL TEXTS.

MOVING ON TO TUDOR TIMES, AND SHAKESPEARE, SO MANY EARLY VERSIONS OF THE BARDS PLAYS AND SONNETS REMAIN THAT TO COVER THEM ALL IS BEYON THE SCOPE (AND INCLINATION) OF THIS ARTICLE. LET IT SUFFICE TO QUOTE BUT THREE EXAMPLES FROM THE MORE WIDELY KNOWN PLAYS.LET US
FIRST TAKE 'THE MERCHANT OF VENICE', WHICH STARTED OUT AS 'THE MERCHANT OF AVTUR' AND CENTRED ON A LEGAL DISPUTE OVER THE MARKETING
RIGHTS BETWEEN ANTONIO (MARKETER OF AVTUR) AND SHYLOCK (DISTRIBUTOR OF AVSHYLD. PORTIA'S SPEECH IN ACT IV SCENE 1 READS:

THE QUALITY OF AVTUR IS NOT STRAIN'D. IT DROPPETH AS THE GENTLE RAIN FROM HEAVEN UPON THE PLACE BENEATH: IT IS TWICE BLESS'D, IT BLESSETH HIM THAT GIVES AND HIM THAT TAKES: 'TIS MIGHTIEST IN THE MIGHTIEST, IT BECOMES THE THRONED MONARCH BETTER THAN HIS CROWN. HIS DEXION SHOWS THE FORCE OF TEMPORAL POWER. THE ATTRIBUTE TO AVE AND MAJESTY.

ANTI-SEMITISM BEING SOMEWHAT IN VOGUE AT THE TIME, SHAKESPEARE SHREWDLY CHANGED THE CHARACTER OF SHYLOCK FROM AN AVTUR MERCHANT TO A MONEYLENDER, REMOULDING BOTH PLOT AND CHARCTERS TO SUIT, AND THUS GIVING THE PLAY ITS MORE RECOGNISABLE FORM.

IN ACT 1 SCENE VII OF MACBETH WE FIND THE THANE OF CAWDOR AND

GLAMIS DEBATING THUS THE PROS AND CONS OF MURDERING KING DUNCAN:
IF IT WERE DONE WHEN'TIS DONE, THEN'TWERE WELL
IT WERE DONE QUICKLY, IF THE ASSASINATION
COULD TRAMMEL UP THE DEXION, AND CATCH

WITH HIS DECEASE SUCCESS.

A WORD OF EXPLANATION IS HELPFUL HERE, UP UNTIL THE TIME OF JAMES V! THE RIGHT OF OWNERSHIP OD DEXION WAS ENTIRELY IN THE HANDS OF THE MONARCH, WHO WOULD GRANT IT AS A PRIVELEDGE TO THOSE IN HIS FAVOUR, SO THAT DEXION BECAME THE PRIME SYMBOL OF REGAL AUTHORITY. THIS PRACTISE WAS ALSO CARRIED OUT ON THE CONTINENT TO A LARGE EXTENT CPORTIA'S SPEECH AGAIN GIVES A GOOD EXAMPLE), WHERE ROYAL DECREES CTHE WORD DECREE' IS ITSELF DERIVED FROM THE TERM DEXARY MEANING 'READ AT THE DEXION' DWERE PROCLAIMED TO THE POPULACE FROM SPECIAL DEXION LECTERNS IN THE MARKET SQUARES OF MANY MAJOR CITIES.

COLERIDGE, AMONGST WHOSE NOTES EXIST STILL THE FOLLOWING LINES FROM KUBLA KHAN:

...SO TWICE FIVE MILES OF FERTILE GROUND

WITH AVTUR DRUMS WERE GIRDLED ROUND
IN ANOTHER NOTE, DEXION IS SUBSTITUTED FOR 'AVTUR DRUMS', AND COLERIDGE WAS PROBABLY STILL DEBATING WHICH OF THE TWO WAS BETTER SUITED
FOR THE VERSE WHEN HE WAS DISTURBED BY AN INSURANCE SALESMAN, WHOM
HE HAD SUCH DIFFICULTY GETTING RID OF, THAT HIS ENTIRE TRAIN OF THOUGHT WAS LOST, AND THE POEM WAS NEVER COMPLETED TO HIS SATISFACTION.

AS A FINAL EXAMPLE, LET US CONSIDER COLERIDGE'S EPIC 'RHYME OF THE ANCIENT MARINER' WHICH WAS FIRST PENNED AS 'THE RHYME OF THE ANCIENT AVTUR DRUM', THE DRASTIC REVISION OF WHICH, NECCESSARY IF COLERIDGE WAS TO MAKE ANY MONEY OUT OF IT, LED TO SUCH A DEPRESSION THAT HE BEGAN TO TAKE, AND EVENTUALLY BECOME ADICTED TO, OPIUM AS A RELIEF. ONLY THE OPENING VERSE OF THIS FIRST VERSION STILL EXISTS, THE REST HAVING BEEN BURNED BY COLERIDGE WHILST IN A DRUGGED STATE, BUT EVEN FROM THIS SOLITARY VERSE, WE MAY YET GLEAN A LITTLE INSIGHT INTO THE MIND OF A MAN WHERE DEXION AND AVTUR SHONE AS GUIDING LIGHTS THROUGH THE DARKNESS:

IT IS AN ANCIENT AVTUR DRUM, BEING TOPPED, ONE OF THREE, BY THY LONG GREY BEARD AND GLITTERING EYE NOW WHEREFORE TOPPS'T THOU ME?

NOT SO MUCH A LITERARY GIANT, MORE A....?


SO, I'VE EVENTUALLY PERSUADED MYSELF TO SIT DOWN AND TRY TO WRITE SOMETHING ORIGINAL FOR THE BASE MAGAZINE. IDEALLY, OF COURSE, IT SHOULD NOT ONLY BE ORIGINAL, BUT WITTY, BRIMMING OVER WITH A UNIQUE HUMOUR THAT WILL OFFEND NOBODY BUT SERVE TO DEMONSTRATE A PREVIOUSLY UNSUSPECTED TALENT FOR CONSTRUCTING THE EVER ELUSIVE QUOTABLE QUOTE, AND IT MUST HAVE A POINT OF VIEW, A SERIOUS NOTE MUST PERVADE THE TEXT AND RAISE ABOVE THE LEVEL OF TRIVIALITY UPON WHICH MUCH INCIDENTAL PROSE FLOUNDERS, SO NOW I HAVE AN ORIGINAL, WITTY PIECE WITH A POINT OF VIEW? WHILST IT MUST BE AGREED THAT ALL ASPECTS ARE NECCESSARY THEY CAN BE SCARCELY CONSIDERED SUFFICIENT. THE READER MUST HAVE AN INCENTIVE TO READ THE PIECE FROM BEGINNING TO END, IN SHORT IT MUST BE INTERESTING. I CANNOT BE CONTENT JUST TO ASSEMBLE IDEAS IN THE MANNER OF A PRODUCTION LINE: THE WHOLE MUST SPEAK OUT - CHALLENGE THE READERS COMPLACENCY AND STRETCH HIS IMAGINATION.

SO, IN THE BEST POSSIBLE MANNER I'VE DEFINED MY OBJECTIVES AND CAN NOW SET OUT TO ATTAIN THEM.











ISOLATION, ALL TOO EASY TO FIND AROUND HALLEY, IS A RATHER MORE PRECIOUS COMMODITY IN THE UK. TO GET AWAY FROM THE CROWDS, ONE HAS TO SEEK THE LESSER KNOWN UPLANDS AND GET AWAY FROM THE WELL-TRODDEN PATHS. BEST OF ALL IS TO HEAD OFF ACROSS THE HILLS AVOIDING ALL MARKED ROUTES. TO DO THIS SAFELY REQUIRES AN ABILITY TO USE MAPS WELL AND NAVIGATE SAFELY.

MAPS ARE A REPRESENTATION OF THE LAND WHICH ARE LIMITED BY THEIR AGE, THE ACCURACY OF THE ORIGINAL SURVEY AND THE WHIMS OF THE CARTO-GRAPHER. THE MOST USED SCALES FOR WALKING ARE 1:50 000 AND 1:25 000 SMALLER SCALE MAPS ARE NOT DETAILED ENOUGH, WHILE LARGE SCALE MAPS GENERALLY COVER TOO SMALL AN AREA. IN BRITAIN, BOTH 1:50 000 AND 1:25 000 ARE DRAWN FROM THE SAME SURVEY AND THE INFORMATION THEY CONTAIN IS SIMILAR. HOWEVER, THE LARGER SCALE MAPS ADDITIONALLY SHOW FIELD BOUNDARIES AND HAVE MORE DETAILED WATER AND ROCK FEATURE INFORMATION. MANY PEOPLE HAVE THE IDEA THAT ORDNANCE SURVEY MAPS ARE ACCURATE AND INFALLABLE. THIS IS BY NO MEANS THE CASE. TOWNS AND ROADS ARE UPDATED REGULARLY, BUT OTHER INFORMATION IS REVISED LESS FREQUENTLY. MOST PROVISIONAL SURVEY 2 1/2 INCH MAPS ARE 30 YEARS OLD AND THE FIRST SERIES 1:50 000 MAPS ARE BASED UPON THEM. THESE MAPS HAVE THE PARTICULAR DISADVANTAGE THAT THE ORIGINAL CONTOURS WERE ONLY SURVEYED AT 100FT INTERVALS: THE INTERMEDIATE CONTOURS BEING INTER-POLATED BY AVERAGING AT THE DRAWING STAGE. THIS LEADS TO FAIRLY LARGE FEATURES BEING ABSENT IN SOME AREAS. THE MODERN 2 1/2 INCH SECOND SERIES AND 1:50 000 MAPS HAVE BEEN COMPLETELY REDRAWN FROM AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND ARE FAR MORE ACCURATE.

BEFORE SETTING OUT, IT IS THEREFORE IMPORTANT TO KNOW THE AGE AND TYPE OF MAP YOU ARE USING AND TO ACQUAINT ONESELF WITH ANY SPECIAL SYMBOLS IN THE LEGEND. THESE CAN BE IMPORTANT - THE NEW TOURIST MAP OF SNOWDONIA IN 1974 USED TWO SYMBOLS THAT DIFFERED ONLY BY A WIDTH DISTANCE OF 0.2MM. CONSCIENTIOUS ATTEMPTS TO FOLLOW THE COUNTY BOUNDARY IN THE MISTAKEN VIEW THAT IT WAS A BRIDLE WAY WOULD HAVE LEAD ONE TO PLUMMET 200FT OVER A CLIFF.A COMPASS - PREFERABLY OF THE COMBINED COMPASS PROTRACTOR (SILVA) TYPE AND A PLASTIC CASE TO PRESERVE THE MAP IN ARE NECCESSARY.MAP CASES IN GENERAL ARE CLUMSY.

EXPENSIVE AND SHORT LIVED.

BECAUSE OF THE AGE OF THE SURVEYS, MAVIGATION IS BEST BASED ON LONG-STANDING FEATURES SUCH AS CONTOURS AND STREAMS. TO DO THIS EASILY, ONE MUST BE ABLE TO VISUALISE THE MAP IN THREE DYMENSIONS -A TECHNIQUE REQUIRING PRACTISE. THE HILL SHADING OF THE ONE-INCH TOURIST MAPS IS A GREAT HELP WHEN STARTING, BUT PRACTISE ENABLES ONE TO BUILD UP A SIMILAR PICTURE ON PLAIN MAPS. CHOOSING THE ROUTE TO BE FOLLOWED IS A MATTER OF PERSONAL TASTE, BUT THE BEST ROUTES USUALLY RETURN SEPARATELY FROM THE OUTGOING TRACK. WHEN GAINING HEIGHT, IT IS. BETTER TO CLIMB UP SPURS AS THE SLOPES ARE LESS STEEP AND VEGETATION LESS DENSE THAN IN VALLEYS AND RE-ENTRANTS. TRYING TO FOLLOW STREAMS. IS OFTEN HARD WORK AS WATER ATTRACTS VEGETATION, DESCENDS BY THE MOST RAPID ROUTE AND CUTS A GULLY. ONLY IF A SHEEP TRACK IS ALONG-SIDE ARE THEY WORTH FOLLOWING AS ROUTES. WHEN TRAVELLING BETWEEN PEAKS STAY AS HIGH AS POSSIBLE AND AVOID TRYING TO CONTOUR ALONG HILLSIDES AS THIS IS SLOW, HARD WORK ON THE ANKLES. ALWAYS SET THE COMPASS TO THE ROUTE THAT YOU WANT TO TRAVEL SO THAT A STRAIGHT LINE CAN BE FOLLOWED EVEN IF THE TARGET IS OBSCURED BY A FALSE SUMMIT OR BAD WEATHER. HILL TRACKS, FOREST BOUNDARIES AND MARKED RIGHTS OF WAY ARE PARTICULARLY INACCURATE ON O.S. MAPS AND SHOULD NEVER BE ASSUMED TO BE CORRECTLY MARKED.

ONE'S SPEED OF PROGRESS DEPENDS UPON THE VEGETATION AND TERRAIN, BUT WILL RARELY BE MORE THAN 2MPH.PLANTATIONS AND FORESTS ARE USUALLY SLOW GOING.SIDES OF HILLS ARE GENERALLY COVERED WITH GORSE AND BRACKEN - EASY GOING IN WINTER AND SPRING, BUT DENSE DURING THE SUMMER HILLTOPS ARE USUALLY MORE WINDSWEPT AND THUS CLEAR - THE BRIGHT GREEN OF THE MOSSY BOG IS TO BE AVOIDED IF ONE WISHES TO AVOID BEEN

THE POSSESSOF OF A STRONG ODOUR OF DRYING SEWAGE.

IN BAD CONDITIONS, IT IS IMPORTANT TO FOLLOW THE MAP CLOSELY. NAVIGATION IS BEST DONE BY HEADING BETWEEN COLLECTING FEATURES SUCH AS STREAM AND WALL JUNCTIONS WHICH CHANNEL ONE TOWARDS A KNOWN POINT. ONE SHOULD ALWAYS BEAR IN MIND THE POSSIBILITY OF THE WEATHER CLAMPING DOWN AND HAVE A SAFETY ROUTE OFF THE HILLS. IF YOU DO GET LOST, THE BEST TECHNIQUE IS TO SIT FACING NORTH WITH THE MAP THE CORRECT WAY UP IN FRONT OF YOU. TRY TO FIT THE TERRAIN TO THE MAP FEATURES SHOWN. IF THIS FAILS, PICK A BEARING THAT WILL TAKE YOU TOWARDS A LARGE AND OBVIOUS FEATURE SUCH AS A ROAD OR LAKE, AND FOLLOW IT. BELIEVE YOUR COMPASS.

EVEN ON A BUSY SUMMER WEEKEND, THERE ARE PARTS OF BRITAIN WHICH REMAIN UNVISITED. THE HOWGILLS AND EASTERN LAKES, THE MID-WALES HILLS, MOELWYNS AND EXMOOR ARE PARTICULARLY WORTH EXPLORING, WHILE MUCH OF SCOTLAND IS DESERTED. WITH MODERN EQUIPMENT, AN OVERNIGHT PACK WITH TENT WEIGHS LESS THAN 20LBS, SO LONGER JOURNEYS ARE EASY. SAFE USE OF MAPS AND DECENT EQUIPMENT GETS ONE AWAY FROM THE STENCH OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND POLLUTION AND INTO A WORLD OF ONE'S OWN.

EXTRACT FROM NEW SCIENTIST.

RECENT EXCAVATIONS IN THE OUTBACK OF AUSTRALIA HAVE REVEALED A REMARKABLE MANUSCRIPT, HITHERTO UNKNOWN, COMPILED BY AN ANCIENT ABORIGINAL NATURALIST - PRESUMABLY AT THE TIME THAT AUSTRALIA AND THE ANTARCTIC WERE JOINED INTO GONDWANALAND. WE REPRODUCE IT IN THE ORIGINAL DIALECT:
WEDDELL MOLE (YGOLOGETEMA).

THIS EXTREMELY RARE CREATURE, IS ONLY KNOWN TO EXIST ON THE WESTN COST OF THE WEDDELL SEA. THE FIRST REPORTED SIGHTING WAS MADE IN 1967 BY E YETTIW BUT AS IT WAS DARK, NO CLEAR DISCRIPTION COULD BE GIVEN. YETTIW CLAIMED THAT WHILST WORKING OUTSIDE AT NIGHT IN THE SPRING OF 67, HE COUGHT A GLIMS OF SOMETHING DISAPPEARING DOWN A HOLE. IN THE SUMMER OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR '68 J NOSNHO DISCOVERED DROPINGS ABOUT 1 KM TO THE SOUTH-EAST OF YETTIW'S SIGHTING THE PREVIOUS YEAR. NO MORE EVIDANCE OF THE WEDDELL MOLE WAS FOUND UNTILL 1971, WHEN G MOCSOR FOLLOWED SOME TRACKS FOR FIVE DAYS, FINALLY LOOSING THEM IN A BLOW. HE HAD FOLLOWED THEM FROM THE SEA ICE TO HIGH ON THE PLATEAU: AN ASTONISHING DISTANCE OF OVER 60 KM ACROSS SOME OF THE WORST TERR-AIN IN THE WORLD. MOCSOR REPORTED THAT THERE WERE PROBABLY 11 WEDDELL MOLES TRAVELLING IN TWO GROUPS OF FOUR AND A GROUP OF THREE. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE GROUP OF THREE WERE JUVENILES, AS THEIR TRACKS WERE SMALLER. THE PURPOUSE OF THIS GREAT TREK STILL REMAINS A MYSTERY. IN 1974, P REHCTOCS MADE AN AMAZING DISCOVERY OF A BURROW, IN THE ICE SHELF 4KM FROM THE YETTIW SIGHTING IN 67. THE ENTERANCE WAS 35 CM DIA. REHCTOCS DUG DOWN 7 MTRS. TRACING ITS PATH, WHICH WAS QUITE VERTICAL, BUT WITH WINTER APROTCHING, HE HAD TO ABANDON IT UNTILL THE NEXT YEAR.

THIS TIME REHCTOCS CAME PREPARED WITH A TEAM OF FIVE MEN INCLUDING PRESY, AN EXPERT ON BADGER BURROWS. THAY TRACED THE BURROW DOWN ITS VERTICAL DROP, OF 22 M, WHERE IT RAN HORIZONTAL, OPENING INTO A HUNEY COMBE OF CHAMBERS AND TUNNALS.

IN THE CHAMBERS REHCTOCS FOUND EVIDANCE OF THE LIVES OF THE MOLES.IN SOME CHAMBERS, HE FOUND TRACES OF FUR ON THE FLOOR, PRESUMABLY THIS WAS THE SLEEPING CHAMBERS. IN ANOTHER HE FOUND REGURGITATED FOOD WHICH HAS NOW BEEN ANALYSED AND FOUND TO CONSIST MAINLY OF FISH. THE MOST STARTLING FIND WAS A VERTICAL BURROW THAT RAN RIGHT THROUGH THE ICE SHELF INTO THE SEA 100 METRES BELOW. THE BURROW HAS BEEN COMPARED TO THAT OF AN OTTER, ALTHOUGH OF A DIFFERENT SCALE. WITH THIS TYPE OF BURROW THE MOLE WOULD HAVE LITTLE NEED TO COME TO THE SERFACE, AND IS THUS PROBABLE WHY IT HAS ONLY BEEN RECORDED SEEN ONCE. REHCTOCS IS BACK IN THE OUTBACK NOW PIECING THE EVIDANCE TOGETHER, BUT NEXT YEAR HE HOPES TO GO BACK, AND PERHAPS FINALLY UNRAVEL THE MYSTERY OF THE WEDDELL MOLE.



OWNERS DRIVING AND MAINTENANCE MANUAL: HALLEY BAY DOGTEAM. ONE HARRY, GT VERSION.

(TO BE READ WHEN YOU HAVE FIVE SECONDS TO SPARE)

1) MAINTENANCE.

NOT A LOT.

FUEL: USE 4-STAR 'CRABEATER' BUT WILL RUN ON 2-STAR 'WEDDELL' AT A PUSH. FOR THAT EXTRA ZIP, 'NUTRICAN' CAN BE USED AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO SEAL BRAND. (CAUTIOUS NOTE: TENDS TO PRODUCE MORE LIQUID RESIDUE FROM POWER PLANT.

LUBRICATION: USE BRUNT'S 'SNOHELT' (CONTAINS WATER, WITH NO ADDITIONAL FLAVOURING OR MONOSODIUM GLUTAMATE).

2) DRIVING

PREPARATION: WEAR THE RIGHT SORT OF CLOTHING. IT IS A LEG PARTICIPAT-ION FORM OF TRANSPORT, SO YOU GET PRETTY HOT. TAKE RESCUE SACK, TRACE, HARNESSES, THUMPER, TILLEY (WHEN DARK), ICE AXE, AND COMPANION. ON REACHING THE SLEDGE, FASTEN TRACE TO SLEDGE AND ANCHOR OTHER END WITH ICE AXE. 1ST GEAR: ONLY TWO GEARS, FAST AND SCOW. FAST IS OBLIGATORY AT START.

CLUTCH OUT: ISSUE FORTH WORDS 'UR' DOGS'.

STEERING: TO TURN RIGHT ISSUE FORTH WORDS 'AUK AUK'. TO TURN LEFT ISSUE FORTH WORDS 'IRE IRE"


